Revenue from SPLOST will allow the county and cities to:

- ✓ Upgrade fire department equipment to improve safety
- ✓ Purchase new patrol cars
- ✓ Resurface and maintain roads and improve storm drainage
- ✓ Purchase heavy equipment for public works
- ✓ Repair and renovate civic buildings
- ✓ Improve water and sewer infrastructure
- ✓ Construct county animal shelter
- Expand and improve parks



- This is **not** an additional tax, it would be a continuation of the current SPLOST.
- Collections will not begin until the current SPLOST ends.
- Sales tax is paid by **everyone** that shops in Lamar County, including visitors.
- Proceeds will be split between the county and the cities.
- Without this revenue the county and cities will likely have to increase property taxes to meet the needs.
