

**LAMAR COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS  
ORDINANCE NO. 2019-08**

**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTER 2-16, ARTICLE I, SECTION 2-16-1 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF LAMAR COUNTY, GEORGIA, ENTITLED “SPECIFICATIONS FOR ROADS COUNTY WILL ACCEPT”; TO CORRECT BUILDING SPECIFICATIONS; TO PROVIDE FOR CODIFICATION; TO PROVIDE FOR SEVERABILITY; TO REPEAL CONFLICTING ORDINANCES; TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER LAWFUL PURPOSES.**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF  
LAMAR COUNTY, GEORGIA**

**Section 1. Code Section Amended.** Chapter 2-16, Article I, Section 2-16-1 of the Lamar County, Georgia, Code of Ordinances is hereby amended as specified below:

By correcting the first sentence of Sec. 2-16-1(e) to read: “The pipe cover (c.d.) shall be at least one-half (1/2) foot.”

*and*

By deleting Sec. 2-16-1(l)(5) in its entirety

**Section 2.** This ordinance shall be codified in a manner consistent with the laws of the State of Georgia.

**Section 3.**

A. It is hereby declared to be the intention of the Board of Commissioners that all sections, paragraphs, sentences, clauses and phrases of this Ordinance are and were, upon their enactment, believed by the Board of Commissioners to be fully valid, enforceable and constitutional.

B. It is hereby declared to be the intention of the Board of Commissioners that, to the greatest extent allowed by law, each and every section, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance is severable from every other section, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance. It is hereby further declared to be the intention of the Board of Commissioners that, to the greatest extent allowed by law, no section, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance is mutually dependent upon any other section, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance.

C. In the event that any section, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance shall, for any reason whatsoever, be declared invalid, unconstitutional or otherwise unenforceable by the valid judgment or decree of any court of

competent jurisdiction, it is the express intent of the Board of Commissioners that such invalidity, unconstitutionality or unenforceability shall, to the greatest extent allow by law, not render invalid , unconstitutional or otherwise unenforceable any of the remaining sections, paragraphs, sentences, clauses or phrases of the Ordinance and that to the greatest extent allowed by law, all remaining sections, paragraphs, sentences, clauses or phrases of the Ordinance shall remain valid, constitutional, enforceable, and of full force and effect.

**Section 4.** Repeal of Conflicting Provisions. Except as otherwise provided herein, all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed.

**Section 5.** Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its adoption by the Board of Commissioners of Lamar County, Georgia.
