Chairman Glass called the Public Hearing to order at 9:02 a.m. Present for the meeting were Chairman Glass, Vice-Chairman Traylor, Commissioner Horton, Commissioner Heiney, Commissioner Thrash, County Administrator Townsend and County Clerk Davidson.

Public Comments

Fred Morris of 168 Howard Road stated that he supports the increase and has lived in Lamar County for over 50 years. He has seen the millage rate go up and down for both the Board of Commissioners and the Board of Education. He says that he feels that the County has the best Board of Commissioners that he has been exposed to and said that he feels that intelligent people given the same circumstance would come up with the same conclusion.
