LAMAR COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS ORDINANCE NO. 2020-06

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE LAMAR COUNTY CODE OF ORDINANCES CHAPTER 2-16 ROADS AND BRIDGES, ARTICLE V ROAD USE AND REGULATION, SEC. 82 ROUTE OF TRAVEL THROUGH TRUCKS; TO REPEAL CONFLICTING ORDINANCES; TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF LAMAR COUNTY, GEORGIA

SECTION 1. <u>Code Chapter Amended.</u> Chapter 2-16, Article V, Sec 82 is hereby amended by the addition of the following:

- (20) Burnette Road;
- (21) Cannafax Road;
- (22) Williams Road;
- (23) Berry Road;
- (24) Grove Street.

SECTION 2.

This ordinance shall be codified in a manner consistent with the laws of the State of Georgia.

SECTION 3.

- A. It is hereby declared to be the intention of the Board of Commissioners that all sections, paragraphs, sentences, clauses and phrases of this Ordinance are and were, upon their enactment, believed by the Board of Commissioners to be fully valid, enforceable and constitutional.
- B. It is hereby declared to be the intention of the Board of Commissioner that, to the greatest extent allowed by law, each and every section, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance is hereby severable from every other Section, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance. It is hereby further declared to be the intention of the Board of Commissioner that, to the greatest extent allowed by law, no section, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance is mutually dependent upon any other Section, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance.
- C. In the event that any section, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance shall, for any reason whatsoever, be declared invalid, unconstitutional or otherwise unenforceable by the valid judgement or decree of any court of competent jurisdiction, it is the express extent of the Board of Commissioners that such invalidity, unconstitutionality or unenforceability shall, to the greatest extent allowed by law, not render invalid, unconstitutional or otherwise unenforceable any of the remaining sections, paragraphs, sentences, clauses, or phrases of the Ordinance and that, to the greatest extent allowed by law, all remaining Sections, paragraphs, sentences, clauses, or phrases of the Ordinance shall remain valid, constitutional, enforceable, and of full force and effect.

SECTION 4

Repeal of Conflicting Provisions. Except as otherwise provided herein, all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed.
