**I. Call to Order**

Chairman Charles Glass called the meeting to order at approximately 9:00 a.m. Present for the meeting were Chairman Charles Glass, Vice-Chair Thrash, Commissioner Horton, Commissioner Heiney, Commissioner Traylor, County Administrator Townsend, and County Clerk Carlette Davidson.

**II. Commissioner Comments regarding the Budget**

Commissioner Heiney stated that County Administrator Townsend had done an extraordinary job with financially managing the County. Commissioner Traylor agreed with this and said that there were a lot of things that went into this budget process. Vice-Chair Thrash agreed with this as well.

Commissioner Heiney inquired about the amount of funds that were allotted for contingency. County Administrator Townsend reported that there is \$360,000.00 dollars allotted for contingency. He said that it is three percent of the total budget. County Administrator Townsend reported that he has allotted \$300,000.00 over the last three years.
